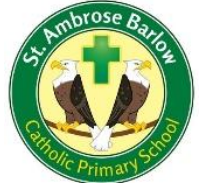


Year 6 News - Spring Term



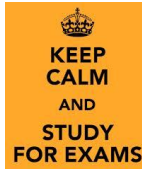
(2nd Half) 2020

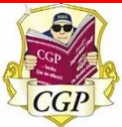
Maths

During this term, the children will be looking at a variety of topics, including **Arithmetic** and **Reasoning**. We will look at:

- Rounding numbers/decimals
- Fractions, Decimals, Percentages
- Algebra (expressing numbers)
- Metric measurements
- Perimeter, Area and Volume
- Ratio, Proportion and Scale.
